Kehelland Village Tea Treat



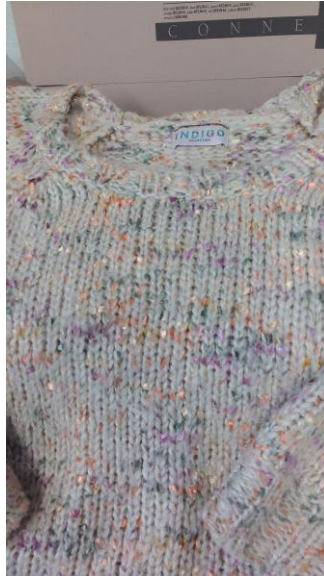
