Early Morning

The computer suite is used in the mornings from 8.20am - 8.45am and again after school from 3pm - 3.20pm for maths academy and accelerated reading programmes. You will be notified if we wish to invite your child in to these sessions. So that the invited children can get the most out of these sessions, we ask that you refrain from letting your child come through the library area unless there are exceptional circumstances in which your child's teacher has agreed an alternative arrangement. The playground is open from 8.30 in the mornings and children can be dropped off from this time providing a teacher is present. If for any reason you need to bring your child in any earlier you will need to supervise them outside yourself until a teacher is present, unless you have made specific arrangements with your Class Teacher.
