Pupil Progress Meetings

Class 1 Reading

Please could all parents try to hear their children read every day. We now only have half of the children in Class 1, reading 5 or more times a week at home. It is absolutely vital that children, at this stage of their learning, practise reading regularly. The session does not need to be long - 5 minutes is ample - but regular practise enables the children to remember their letters and sounds and to begin to recognise high frequency words on sight.
