Love My World Club

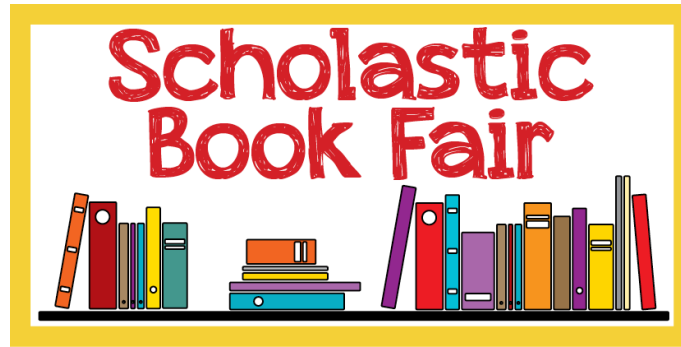
