Gig On The Green 2019

This year's GOTG will be on Friday 5th July. Tickets are available for £3 per adult (children are free) and can be bought in advance or on the night.

3pm - 5pm:	Camping set-up Face-painting, glitter tattoos and other children's activities (<i>small charge applies</i>)
5pm - 5.45pm:	Children's food & light refreshments served
6pm - 7.30pm:	Children's parade and performances
7.30pm onwards:	Further musical entertainment Adult food & light refreshments served (until approx. 8.30pm)

**** PLEASE NOTE: There will be no food or refreshments served between 5.45pm and 7.30pm to allow our volunteers to watch their children perform. Thank-you. ****

Camping

Camping (in tents / campervans) is available on the school field for the Friday night - there is a small fee of £6 per pitch. Please book this in advance.

Those camping will be able to set-up from 3pm – **for safety reasons please can you make sure that all cars have left the field by 5pm & that campervans are parked / no longer moving about after this time.**

There will be a "Best Decorated Tent / Campervan" competition again this year - free to enter; the winning tent/campervan will win the cost of their camping pitch.

Entertainment

The children's parade will open the evening's entertainment at 6pm. Please can all children be at school by 5.45pm to get ready - children will need to assemble in the playground at 5.55pm.

This year's theme is The Cornish Coast - please can children wear something that will fit within this theme. (Full dress-up is welcome for both children and adults, but is in no way compulsory, so if your child simply wants to wear something blue or yellow, that is absolutely fine.)

The children's performances will follow the parade.

There will then be a variety of musical performances during the evening, including a session by The Great Apes. We anticipate the musical performances finishing at approx. 10/10.30pm.

Food & refreshments

This year we are offering Hot Dogs (vegetarian / vegan available) for children between 5pm and 5.45pm at a cost of £2.50 each.

We will then be serving adult meals after the children’s performances are finished (approximately 7.30pm) - this year we are offering homemade Malaysian vegetable curry, served either with Chicken or Aubergine Steak, with flat bread and homemade slaw accompaniments, at a cost of £5 per portion.

(Adults are, of course, welcome to order themselves a hot dog and likewise the children can order a portion of the curry, but they will only be served during the corresponding times above - the idea being that the children can eat before their performances instead of having to wait until 7.30pm.)

There will also be various drinks and light refreshments available, such as teas, coffees, squash, ice-cream and cakes.

**** New for 2019!!** This year we are also running a bar, offering a small selection of alcoholic drinks. ******
