The children had a wonderful day yesterday at the Beach despite the rather blustery conditions. Below are some photos:

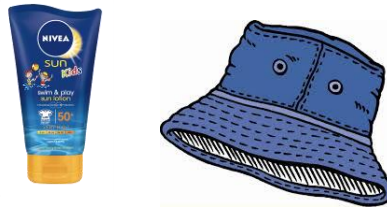


Sports Day
