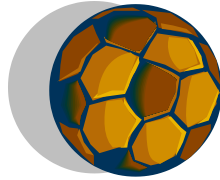

TT Rockstars



All children in Year 2 to Year 6 will be set up with a TT Rockstars account. The login details etc, will be put in their school diaries. This online programme increases their knowledge and speed in their times tables and should be used frequently at home, we recommend 2 to 3 times a week for a period of 10 minutes. The programme automatically assesses and monitors in order that the times tables are set to the appropriate level for the child. The children will be given their login details etc and be set up to begin next week.

Morning Break



Children in KS1 (Reception to Y2) are entitled to free fruit for their morning break. We would encourage all other children to bring some fruit for their morning break but this will have to be provided from home.
